

Scarf Play

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1. **Move & track** the scarf with eyes or hands.
2. **Rub** the scarf. (feel texture / sensory motor)
 - o How does it **feel**? Soft or hard?
 - o How does it **sound**? Loud or quiet?
 - o What **color** is it?
 - o What **word** would you use to **describe** it?
3. **Look through** the scarf. (sensory motor)
 - o What do you **see**? Clear or cloudy?
 - o Play "**Peek-a-Boo**" with a neighbor
4. **Blow** the scarf. What happens?
(force and motion)
5. **Thread** through yours or your neighbor's fingers.
Pull scarves **from** a box / bag / ball / whisk.
6. Magically turn the scarf into **imaginary things**:
a horse's tail, waves, fireworks, a kite, a carousel.
7. Make **big**, **small**, and **tiny** wide, movements.
8. **Shake** high, low, in between, behind, around, etc.
9. **Shake** to the tempo of a song.
Sing "Row, Row, Row Your Boat"
10. Shake and sing **faster** and **slower**. **Very slow!**
11. Free **dance**.
12. Air draw **lines & pathways**: circles, straight lines, wavy lines, curves, and zigzag lines.
9. **Paint body parts**.
10. **Paint objects** in the room.
Use positional and directional words.
"Paint on **top** of the table, paint **under**."
13. **Pass** the scarves around the table. STOP!
"Did you get the same color you had before?"
14. Play "**Hide and Seek**." Go find it!
15. Make shapes – rectangle
 - ◇ Say the shape in **another language**.
 - ◇ **Fold and resize** your shape:
smaller, tiny, larger, huge
 - ◇ **Count** sides and corners.
 - ◇ **Count** in **another language**.
 - ◇ **Shake** it out – make **another shape**.
16. Drop and catch the scarf before it hits the floor.
 - ◇ Catch with **both** hands.
 - ◇ Catch with **pincher fingers**.
 - ◇ Catch with **one hand**.
17. Throw the scarf **overhead** from one hand to the other.
18. **Toss and Catch**
 - Solo
 - With a peer
 - To each other at the same time
19. **Toss** and do a **motor skill** before catching the scarf: clap, wave, kick, jump, etc.
20. Instead of "Red Light Green Light,"
play "Up High, Down Low"
or "In close, Out far"
21. **Juggle** multiple scarves.
22. **Roll** or **fold** and stack the scarves.
23. Use a scarf to **carry** lightweight **objects**
with a peer.
24. Team up to make a **pattern**.
25. Lay the scarves end to end to make a **graph**.
26. Manipulate the scarves on the table/floor to
make a **BIG mosaic** or work of art.
