
- 1. Print Page 3.
- 2. Count the fingers on each hand.
- 3. Trace over the outlines of the hands on the paper and decorate them using different colors and shapes.
- 4. Help your child measure how tall and wide the hands are using the squares on the page or small manipulatives that can be lined up end-to-end (cube, Legos, or tiny animals).

Help your child trace his/her hands on a blank piece of paper. Compare and contrast the difference between the child's hand and the hands on the paper. Hold the 2 papers up to the light and observe the differences. Trace your adult hand and compare and contrast your hands to those of your child. Now, take a look at your real hands.

QUESTIONS:

- What are the differences between the adult's and the child's hand?
- What are the similarities?
- Which hand/s or fingers/s are bigger | smaller | wider | thinner?
- What does the child notice about the hand/s?
- What about skin color | nails | veins | bones?

Trace and measure the child's hands again in 6 months or a year to see if there have been any changes.

Open in APP or PRINT on paper. In APP, trace the number inside of each drum using your finger a stylus. On paper, trace with crayon, pencil, marker, etc.
